Newspapers, Magazines, Junk Mail, Phone Books, Paper Bags, Shoe Boxes, Cereal & Food Boxes (*remove inside wrappers*), Corrugated Cardboard (*Cut Down to 2'x2' or smaller*)



Bin 2 Glass, Cans, Plastic (1 thru 7)

Bottles and Jars
Steel, Aluminum, Tin Foil



(Throw lids in trash)

Pizza Boxes, Egg Cartons, Paper Milk or Juice Cartons, Contaminated Paper Products, Empty Motor Oil Bottles & Empty Chemical Bottles, Spray Cans, Styrofoam Products, Alkaline Batteries, Broken Glass, Regular Light Bulbs, Dried Up Paint and Empty Paint Cans (lids off all cans)

Call BFI at **1-800-425-0095** *at least two days before* your trash day to get on their list.
Drain Gas & Oil from Mowers, Put out on trash day. **(One per week per house)**



Bulky Items (one per week per house)

Ex: Household Furniture, Couch, Chair, Mattress, Microwave Oven, Table, Dresser, Bundle of Wood (less than 4' long), Pizza Boxes (tie together), Dehumidifier, Styrofoam blocks (tie together), Gas Bar-B-Que Grill (remove propane tank)



Unlimited Curbside Yard Waste Pickup (April 4 thru December 9)



(Leaves, grass, branches less than 4" thick)

Place at Curb loose in trash barrels or in paper bags only. Same day as your trash day. **No plastic bags!**

Tires, Automotive Batteries, Motor Oil, Propane Tanks, Mercury Products, Cardboard, Fluorescent Bulbs Liquefied Paint (April 1 thru October 31 only), Charitable Donations, Ni-Cad (rechargeable) and Lithium Batteries

(No driveway sealer, no roofing tar, no drywall compound, no non-paint products)

- ✓ Liquid latex & oil paints (Throw away dry or empty cans in regular trash, **lids off**)
- ✓ Paint Thinner & Solvents

First 25 one gallon containers per season free, Additional cans \$1.00 each

Automotive Items

- ✓ Car Tires \$2.00 off rim/\$3.00 on rim
- ✓ Truck tires Less than 40" - \$6.00 off rim / \$10.00 on rim (over 40" see attendant)
- ✓ Waste Oil \$1.00 one gallon or less/ \$1.00 each additional gallon
- ✓ Automotive Batteries \$2.00
- ✓ Oil Filter \$1.00
- ✓ Antifreeze, Transmission Fluid, Diesel Fuel, Heating Oil \$1.00 per gallon

Mercury Containing Materials – No Charge

- ✓ Fluorescent Lights
- ✓ Thermostats & Thermometers
- ✓ Rechargeable and Lithium Batteries

Propane Tanks

- ✓ Grill Size (20#) \$3.00/ 1# \$1.00/ Other \$20.00, Helium Tanks \$3.00

Appliances & Electronics

- ✓ Appliances with Freon \$20.00/ Without Freon \$10.00
- ✓ TV's Console \$25.00/ Portable \$10.00/ Computer Monitors \$10.00
